### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

### **ASSUMPTION**

In response to a previous version of this proposal (FN# 0339-01/Perfected HB 53), officials with the **Department of Transportation** (MoDOT) assumed that unless civic organizations or individual donors contribute funds for the fabrication and installation costs of the signs, MoDOT will be required to bear the costs, to be paid from the Road Fund.

**Oversight** assumes that private organizations or individuals will pay for the appropriate signage, resulting in no fiscal impact to MoDOT or other agencies.

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#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

### **DESCRIPTION**

This legislation names a portion of U.S. Highway 412 in Dunklin and Pemiscot Counties as the "Governor John M. Dalton Memorial Highway" and the bridge crossing the Missouri River on State Highway 13 between Lafayette and Ray Counties as the "Congressman Ike Skelton Bridge."

This legislation also designates two bridges in Polk County: one on State Highway 123 as the "Ed Brown Bridge", and another on State Highway 215 as the "Glen Sharp Bridge".

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
