FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue - Division of Motor Vehicle and Driver Licensing (MVDL)** assume the Missouri Driver License System (MODL), Central Driver Information System (CDIS), Missouri Transportation Accounting System (MTAS), and the Over-the-Counter (OTC) license system will require program modifications in order to build appropriate accounting processes for reinstatement transaction processing. The Customer Assistance Bureau will be responsible for testing the systems in order to ensure the programs function properly before installing the new programs in the field offices.

Customer Assistance Bureau (CAB)

CAB will require overtime hours in order to test the program modifications that are made to the automated systems.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
