FISCAL ANALYSIS

<u>ASSUMPTION</u>

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives**, **Office of Lieutenant Governor**, and **Missouri Senate** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources (DNR)** assume there would be an unknown cost to the state for establishing a statewide historical monument as outlined in the proposal.

The proposal would require the Department of Economic Development, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, and DNR to provide administrative support as necessary to assist in the performance of the commission's duties. It is unknown what level of support would be necessary to carry out the activities of the commission. The DNR assumes additional resources needed, if any, would be requested through the normal budgetary process.

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development (DED)** anticipates 0.5 FTE Economic Development Incentive Specialist II would be needed to perform the duties outlined in this proposal. In addition, the DED would have to provide meeting space for the nine (9) commission members plus expenses. Four meetings are projected per year. Costs include overnight lodging, mileage, and meals plus printing and meeting room expenses. Advertising and promotion costs are anticipated but unknown. The cost to put on the celebration is also

unknown. The DED estimates FY 06 expenses as unknown exceeding \$45,515; FY 07 expenses are unknown exceeding \$46,866; and FY 08 expenses are unknown exceeding \$48,126.

Oversight assumes the DED would delegate the duties associated with the Emancipation Day Commission and organizing the Juneteenth Heritage and Jazz Festival to existing staff.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DES)** state the administrative duties that may arise as a result of subsections 5 and 6 could be significant. As a minimum, the DES will require 0.5 FTE Administrative Assistant to provide administrative support as necessary to assist in the performance of the commission's duties and to administer activities relating to events and monuments associated with the Emancipation Day Celebration.

Oversight assumes the DES would delegate the duties associated with the commission and the activities relating to the Emancipation Day Celebration to existing staff.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal establishes the Emancipation Day Commission within the Department of Economic Development. The nine-member commission will designate a statewide Juneteenth Heritage and Jazz Festival which will recognize the economic and cultural values associated with African Americans. The commission will be responsible for all activities relating to the events and monuments associated with the Emancipation Day Celebration.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
