FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of Secretary of State** stated that statewide newspaper publication of state statutes cost approximately \$1,289 per column inch based on estimate provided by the Missouri Press Service x 3 for multiple printings as required by the Constitution and state statute = \$3,867 per column inch. Estimate total number of inches for this amendment to be 15 inches, which includes title header and certification paragraph. \$3,867 x 15 inches = \$58,005.

Officials of the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Laclede County Clerk's Office** assume there would be no fiscal impact.

DESCRIPTION


This proposed Constitutional Amendment increases legislative term limits from eight to twelve years and increases the term of office for State Representative from two to four years after the 2008 General Election.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
