FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This bill requires that persons appointed to both the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission and the State Board of Mediation serve 50% of a term in order to qualify for participation in the Administrative Law Judges and Legal Advisors Retirement System.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
