FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill establishes requirements for serving on a civilian review board that is responsible for investigating allegations of misconduct by local law enforcement officers. Every member is required to be at least 18 years old, a registered voter residing in the city or county, and have not been convicted of or pled guilty or nolo contendere to or have been found guilty of any felony, class A or B misdemeanor, or any crime including the assault of a law enforcement officer, resisting an arrest or fleeing under the laws of the state of Missouri, or any other state, of the United States, or of any other country, whether a sentence is or was imposed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
