ASSUMPTION

Officials from Laclede County assume this proposal would not fiscally impact their county.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** assume this proposal gives nursing home districts the ability to establish senior apartments or senior housing adjacent to or next to long-term care facilities. Since entities who provide room and board but do not provide protective oversight are not required to be licensed by the DOH pursuant to Chapter 198, RSMo, there would be no fiscal impact to the DOH as a result of this proposal.
