### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

### **DESCRIPTION**

The proposed legislation would specify that unless there is clear and convincing evidence to the contrary, it is in the best interests of a minor to terminate a guardianship granted to someone other than a parent if a parent is fit, suitable, and able to assume the duties of the minor's guardian.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
