FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

The proposal could have a fiscal impact on small businesses providing probation and rehabilitation services.

DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would allow municipal judges to employ a person, or to contract with a public entity to provide probation services for people convicted of municipal ordinance violations, such as driving while intoxicated. Current law allows municipal judges to contract only with private entities for probation services.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
