FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This bill repeals several provisions of law which currently prohibit any Kansas City police officer from:

- (1) Belonging to a committee of a political party;
- (2) Soliciting any person to vote for or against any candidate;
- (3) Making or soliciting contributions for any kind of political activity; or
- (4) Allowing any solicitation of contributions to take place on police department property.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
