FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Currently, four of the eight members of the Regional Taxicab Commission must be representatives of the taxicab industry, and the chairperson may be a taxicab industry representative. This bill prohibits representatives of the taxicab industry, their spouses, or anyone with a financial interest in the industry from serving on the commission. An advisory committee, comprised of five taxicab industry representatives, is established.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
