#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The proposed legislation would increase the time parties are allowed to request the circuit court to review a report in condemnation proceedings from 10 days after service of the notice to 30 days after service.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
