FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill repeals the statutes creating the Upper White River Basin Watershed Improvement District and removes the requirement that any person installing on-site sewer disposal systems be registered by the Department of Health and Senior Services. The department is required to receive a complaint before determining whether a water and sewer system violation has occurred.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
