ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of Secretary of State** stated that advertisement costs for the proposal would be \$58,005 per column inch for three printings of the text of the proposal, the introduction, fiscal note summary, and affidavit. The ninety-seventh general assembly would begin in **January of 2013**; therefore, there would be no costs or savings in the years shown on the normal fiscal note.
