### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of Secretary of State** stated that advertisement costs for the proposal would be \$58,005 per column inch for three printings of the text of the proposal, the introduction, fiscal note summary, and affidavit. The proposal would be on the ballot for the November 2006 general election.

The ninety-seventh general assembly would begin in **January of 2013**; therefore, there would be no costs or savings in the years shown on the normal fiscal note.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

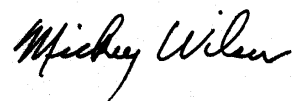
DESCRIPTION

This proposed constitutional amendment decreases, upon voter approval, the number of members of the Missouri House of Representatives from 163 to 137 beginning with the 97th General Assembly in 2013.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
