FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume that any potential costs arising from this proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** and the **Office of Administration**, **Division of Personnel**, assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** (DOLIR) assume this proposal would result in the elimination of two positions; the chair of the State Board of Mediation and the secretary to the chair. The proposal would make the chair of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission the chair of the State Board of Mediation. DOLIR calculated savings of \$123,949 for FY 2006, and \$148,739 for FY 2007 and FY 2008.

Oversight notes that the FY 2006 DOLIR budget lists a total of \$103,449 for salaries for the State Board of Mediation and \$45,290 for fringe benefits. Oversight has shown these numbers, adjusted for inflation, as the savings resulting from this proposal.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This proposal would eliminate the State Board of Mediation as a separate entity under the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations. The chair of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission would be a member of the State Board of Mediation and would assume the duties of and serve as the chair of the State Board of Mediation.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
