DESCRIPTION



This proposed legislation limits a school district superintendent's salary to 1.5 times the highest teacher's salary for any school district whose boundaries overlap counties of the third and fourth classification.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
