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FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would require class action lawsuits for unlawful merchandising practices to have a minimum of 10 named plaintiffs and contain provisions for the payment of attorney fees in cases where the proposed settlement provides for a recovery of coupons to a class member. The court would be required to approve attorney fees and could approve a proposed coupon settlement only after conducting a hearing to determine whether the settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate. The court could require the distribution of a portion of the value of some of the unclaimed coupons to governmental or charitable organizations.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
