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### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small tax practitioners who file more than 200 individual tax returns per year could encounter additional costs for training, technology, and software as a result of this proposal.

### **DESCRIPTION**

This legislation requires tax preparers who file more than 200 individual income tax returns each year to file and pay the returns electronically. The bill grants an extension of time in Missouri to match the federal individual income tax return due date, as long as the federal return is also filed electronically.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
