# **HOUSE BILL NO. 11**

#### **AN ACT**

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, and distributions of the Department of Social Services and the Office of Administration, and the several divisions and programs thereof to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the period beginning July 1, 2005 and ending June 30, 2006.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the purpose of funding each department, division, agency, and program enumerated in each section for the item or items stated, monies are not appropriated for coverage of medical assistance provided after August 27, 2005, for adults receiving old age assistance benefits or permanently and totally disabled benefits whose income exceeds eighty-five percent (85%) of the federal poverty level. Monies are not appropriated for coverage of medical assistance provided after August 27, 2005, for persons receiving benefits under RSMo 208.146. Monies are not appropriated for coverage of medical assistance provided after June 30, 2005, for adults receiving benefits under the Medical Assistance for Families program whose income exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the federal poverty level, and for no other purpose whatsoever chargeable to the fund designated for the
