#### **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of a memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 227.304, to read as follows:

227.304. The portion of U.S. Highway 160 in Taney County from state route 76,

- 2 known as the Kissee Mills Junction, to state route 125, known as the Rueter Junction, shall
- 3 be designated the "Rick Harmon Memorial Highway". Costs for such designation shall
- 4 be paid by private donations.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
