AN ACT

To amend chapter 610, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to personal records with unique identifiers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 610, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 610.040, to read as follows:

**610.040. No branch, division, department, office, or agency of state government or
2 any political subdivision thereof shall employ any inmate of a correctional facility or any
3 other person with a criminal record in any position where such inmate or other person
4 would have access to the personal records of any person whose records contain any type
5 of unique personal identifiers including, but not limited to, residential addresses, telephone
6 numbers, or e-mail addresses, driver's license numbers, or Social Security numbers.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
