	Whereas, the Government Pension Offset (GPO) and Windfall Elimination
2 3 4	Provision (WEP) of the federal Social Security Act penalize people who have dedicated their lives to public and military service by taking away benefits they have earned; and
5	Whereas, nine out of ten public employees affected by the GPO lose their entire
6 7	spousal benefit, even though their spouse paid Social Security taxes for many years; and
8	Whereas, the WEP causes hard-working people to lose up to sixty percent of the
9 10	benefits they earned themselves; and
11	Whereas, many workers rely on misleading Social Security Administration
12 13	statements that fail to take into account the GPO and WEP when projecting benefits; and
14	Whereas, the impact of the GPO and WEP is not just felt in those states in which
15 16 17	public employees, including retired veterans, are not covered by Social Security, because people move from state to state and affected individuals are everywhere; and
18 19	Whereas, the GPO and WEP apply to Missouri retired veterans; and
20	Whereas, the number of people affected across the country is growing every day
21 22	as more and more people reach retirement age; and
23	Whereas, some 300,000 individuals lose an average of \$3,600 a year due to the

2425	GPO which can make the difference between self-sufficiency and poverty; and
26	Whereas, these people have less money to spend in their local economy and
27	sometimes have to turn to expensive government programs like food stamps to make ends meet;

30	Whereas, the nation should respect, not penalize, public and military service; and

32	Whereas, the GPO and WEP are established in federal law and repeal of the GPO
33	and WEP can only be enacted by the United States Congress:

35	Now, therefore, be it resolved that the members of the House of
36	Representatives of the Ninety-third General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
37	concurring therein, hereby urge the Congress of the United States to immediately repeal the
38	Government Pension Offset and Windfall Elimination Provision of the Social Security Act; and

40	Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
41	Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed copies of this resolution for the
42	President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives
43	and the members of the Missouri Congressional delegation.
