AN ACT

To repeal section 287.845, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the administrative law judges and legal advisors retirement system.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 287.845, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as sections 287.813 and 287.845, to read as follows:

287.813. Any administrative law judge or legal advisor who is employed on or after January 1, 2006, and who has not previously been covered by the administrative law 2 judge's and legal advisor's retirement system under sections 287.812 to 287.856, shall not 3 be eligible to participate in that system. Such administrative law judge or legal advisor 4 shall participate in the state employees' retirement system under chapter 104, RSMo, if 5 otherwise eligible under the applicable provisions of law contained in that chapter. 6 287.845. 1. The board shall administer the provisions of sections 287.812 to 287.855 and shall have the same powers, duties, and obligations in regard to the funds and the system 2 3 provided for in such sections as it has in regard to the Missouri state employees' retirement 4 system. The system shall calculate the annuity for an administrative law judge or legal advisor, 5 as defined in section 287.812 based on the law in effect at the time the administrative law judge's

- 6 or legal [advisory's] **advisor's** employment was terminated.

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Missouri state employees' retirement system shall perform the same duties in regard to the 8 9 retirement system established pursuant to the provisions of sections 287.812 to 287.855 that are prescribed for such officers in sections 104.436 and 104.438, RSMo, in regard to the Missouri 10 11 state employees' retirement system. Funds so certified and transferred for the retirement system 12 established pursuant to the provisions of sections 287.812 to 287.855 shall be deposited in a separate account of the Missouri state employees' retirement fund and shall be disbursed only for 13 the purposes of sections 287.812 to 287.855. 14 15 3. Effective January 1, 2006, the liabilities and assets of the administrative law

judge's and legal advisor's retirement system shall be transferred and combined with the 16 state employees' retirement system. The contribution rate certified by the board pursuant 17 to section 104.1066, RSMo, for the state employees' retirement system after January 1, 18 19 2006, shall include amounts necessary to cover the costs of the administrative law judge's 20 and legal advisor's retirement system. No alteration, amendment, or repeal of the 21 administrative law judge's and legal advisor's retirement system shall affect the then existing rights of members, or their spouses, beneficiaries or former spouses, but shall be 22 23 effective only as to rights which would otherwise accrue hereunder as a result of services 24 rendered by a member after such alteration, amendment, or repeal.
