## AN ACT

To repeal section 301.3132, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to professional engineers license plate.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 301.3132, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 301.3132, to read as follows:

301.3132. 1. Any member of or designated by the Missouri Society of Professional 2 Engineers may receive special license plates as prescribed by this section, for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a 3 4 commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight, after an annual payment of an emblem-use authorization fee to the Missouri Society of Professional 5 6 Engineers Educational Foundation. The Missouri Society of Professional Engineers hereby authorizes the use of its official emblem to be affixed on multiyear personalized license plates 7 8 as provided in this section. Any contribution to the Missouri Society of Professional Engineers 9 Educational Foundation derived from this section, except reasonable administrative costs, shall 10 be used solely for the purposes of the Missouri Society of Professional Engineers Educational Foundation and shall be deposited into the society's educational fund. Any member of or person 11 designated by the Missouri Society of Professional Engineers may annually apply for the use of 12 13 the emblem.

Upon annual application and annual payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use
 contribution to the Missouri Society of Professional Engineers [Educational Foundation], the
 organization shall issue to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an emblem-use

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authorization statement, which shall be presented by the owner to the department of revenue at 17 18 the time of registration of a motor vehicle. Upon presentation of the annual statement, payment 19 of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration fee and documents which may be required 20 by law, the department of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a personalized license plate 21 which shall bear the emblem of the Missouri Society of Professional Engineers and the words "[MISSOURI SOCIETY OF] PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS" in place of the words 22 23 "SHOW-ME STATE". Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a 24 common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically 25 attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, 26 no additional fee shall be added or charged for the personalization of license plates issued 27 pursuant to this section.

3. A vehicle owner, who was previously issued a plate with the Missouri Society of
Professional Engineers' emblem authorized by this section but who does not provide an
emblem-use authorization statement at the subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new
plate which does not bear the Missouri Society of Professional Engineers' emblem, as otherwise
provided by law.

33 4. The director of the department of revenue shall make necessary rules and regulations 34 for the administration of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by this 35 section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the authority of this section shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to the provisions of chapter 536, 36 37 RSMo. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, that is 38 created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies 39 with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, section 40 536.028, RSMo. This section and chapter 536, RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers 41 vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the 42 effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the 43 grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2004, shall be 44 invalid and void.
