## AN ACT

To amend chapter 195, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prescription drugs obtained outside the United States.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 195, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 195.001, to read as follows:

**195.001. The state of Missouri and Missouri residents are not prohibited or**  
2 **precluded from participating in any current or future state program, service, policy, or**  
3 **practice permitting prescription drugs to be obtained from Canada, including but not**  
4 **limited to the I-SaveRx program.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
