AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to the establishment of memorial highways.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be
2 known as sections 227.305 and 227.375, to read as follows:

227.305. The portion of state highway M within Washington county which is
2 located within the city limits of Irondale shall be designated the "Trooper Robert Kolilis
3 Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain
4 appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by the Missouri
5 State Troopers' Association.

227.375. The portion of U.S. highway 54 located within Camden county from the
2 eastern city limits of Macks Creek to the western city limits of Camdenton shall be
3 designated the "Trooper Ross S. Creach Memorial Highway". The department of
4 transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with
5 the costs to be paid for by the Missouri State Troopers' Association.
