AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to holidays.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.015, to read as follows:

**9.015. For any holiday observed, recognized, or otherwise referred to by any state
2 department or agency, public school, any public institution of higher education, or any
3 political subdivision of this state, such department, agency, public school, institution of
4 higher education, or political subdivision shall, for all purposes, use the traditional name
5 of the holiday, including but not limited to use of the traditional holiday names of "New
6 Year's Day", "Martin Luther King Jr Day", "Lincoln's Birthday", "Washington's
7 Birthday", "Easter", "Truman Day", "Memorial Day", "Fourth of July" or
8 "Independence Day", "Labor Day", "Columbus Day", "Veterans Day", "Thanksgiving
9 Day", "Hanukkah", "Christmas", and "Kwanzaa".**
