AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the display of the POW/MIA flag.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.136, to read as follows:

**9.136. All government buildings, businesses, and citizens of the state of Missouri
2 are encouraged to display the POW/MIA flag, which is designed to commemorate the
3 service and sacrifice of the members of the armed forces of the United States who were
4 prisoners of war or missing in action, on Memorial Day, the Fourth of July, September
5 eleventh, and Veterans Day.**
