ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of Secretary of State- Elections Division** assume no cost to their office or to state funds.

Officials of the **Office of Cass County Clerk** assume the change would have no fiscal impact on their county.

The **City Clerk of the City of Spickard** assume there would be cost of less than \$150 annually of providing salary for 5 rather than 4 Alderman.

Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive and would only have fiscal impact if the City Aldermen would elect to provide for at-large-elections for City Aldermen. Oversight assumes no fiscal impact.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This bill authorizes the board of aldermen in any city of the fourth class with 700 or fewer inhabitants to dissolve the ward districts and elect five aldermen at large.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
