FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of State Auditor** assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of Jefferson County assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of **Jasper County** assume this proposal would affect smaller counties by allowing them to summarize financial statements and resulting in some insignificant savings. Officials estimated annual savings at \$100 to \$200.

Officials of Platte and Cass County assume no fiscal impact.

Oversight will show savings, from reduced cost of publication of annual financial statement, to certain counties as minimal, probably less than \$1,000 annually. Any savings would depend upon the size of the county.

Oversight sent response request to Callaway, Cole, Franklin, Marion, Webster, Laclede, Taney, and many other counties.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill requires all noncharter counties to prepare and publish a summary financial statement. Currently, counties of the second, third, and fourth classification are required to prepare and publish detailed financial statements.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
