## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

### **DESCRIPTION**

This proposed legislation establishes the Founding Documents Protection Act and specifies that no teacher or administrator will be prohibited from reading or posting any excerpt from a specified list of documents and verses related to American and Missouri history, patriotism, and civil rights in public school buildings or at school events. Censorship of any of the specified items based on religious reference is prohibited.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
