FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Missouri Department of Transportation** assume no fiscal impact to their department.

Officials of Jasper County and Cass County assume no local fiscal impact.

Officials of **Hickory County** assume there would be costs associated with a hearing and filing of documents.

Oversight assumes that current law mandates that whenever a County Commission is presented with a petition for construction of a county road, and the petition has met the requirements of Sections 228.020 and 228.030, and a remonstrance has not been filed, the County Commission must open the petitioned road. This proposal would allow the County Commission at their discretion to determine if the opening or construction of a county road is in the public interest.

Oversight assumes no fiscal impact.
