No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This bill designates the bridges on State Highway 60 over the Current River located within the limits of the City of Van Buren as the "Sgt. Dewayne Graham, Jr. Memorial Bridge MO State Hwy Patrol." The costs will be paid by the Missouri State Troopers Association.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
