ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Facilities Management Design and Construction (DFMDC)** assume the majority of their signage has the emblem that represents disabled accommodations and does not include verbage. If they have to change the emblem signage to include the verbage "Accessible Parking" there could be a fiscal impact statewide. Dollars unknown. If they do not have to include new verbage on their current emblem signage there would be no fiscal impact. They may have a few signs with minor changes and any associated cost can be absorbed into their current DFMDC overhead.

Officials from the Missouri Highway Patrol, Department of Transportation, Department of Conservation, County of Jefferson, Platte County, Nodaway County, City of Kansas City, and Greene County assume no fiscal impact to their agency.
