## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Currently, access to official court records for persons arrested and charged, but the case is subsequently nolle prossed, dismissed, or the accused is found not guilty or imposition of sentence is suspended, is limited to law enforcement agencies, child care agencies, residential care facilities, and skilled nursing facilities. The proposed legislation authorizes access to official court records to victims, or victims parents or guardian if the victim is a minor, for certain sexual offenses or offenses against the family found in Chapters 566 and 568, RSMo, for the purpose of using the records in his or her own judicial proceeding.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
