#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

## **DESCRIPTION**

This proposal allows for the deployment of any health care professional licensed, registered, or certified in this state or any adjoining state who volunteers during an emergency declared by the Governor and provides them immunity from civil damages for providing services. Currently, only workers licensed, registered, or certified in this state are allowed to be deployed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
