FISCAL ANALYSIS

<u>ASSUMPTION</u>

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary** of state (SOS) assume this proposal would create a fee waiver for access to or copying of public records where another law requires the records to be published in a newspaper. The fee waiver applies when the public body has failed to publish the records. All Archives staff make copies for patrons as needed and the per hour pay range is from \$9.50-\$22. The impact of this legislation is unknown because the application of the fee waiver for access to or copying of public records depends upon the frequency public bodies fail to publish public records in a newspaper as required by law.

Officials from **Truman State University** stated they could not determine the fiscal impact of this proposal on their organization.

Oversight assumes that the impact of this proposal would be minimal and could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** (AGO) assume the proposal could result in additional inquiries regarding the Sunshine Law; however, the AGO assumes the number of new inquiries would be minimal and could be absorbed with existing resources.
