### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **St. Louis County Department of Justice Services** assume the proposal would result in a savings to their department. Officials assume one less day of incarceration would be served for each warrant served since there would not be any delay in the service. In the last two years, an average of 90 warrants per year have been served on confined persons. This would translate to a savings of approximately \$7,200 per year (per diem of \$80 x 90 persons).

**Oversight** assumes the proposal could result in a savings to local law enforcement agencies may experience a savings in incarceration costs. Oversight assumes this savings would be unknown, but less than \$100,000 per fiscal year.

**Officials from the Clark County Sheriff's Department, Greene County Sheriff's Department, and the Jackson County Sheriff's Department did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.**

The proposed legislation authorizes jailers to serve arrest warrants on individuals who are already inmates in the custody of the facility in which the jailer is employed.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
