FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal provides that no hospital governing body shall refuse or fail to grant or renew staff privileges, or condition staff privileges based on the fact that a physician, dentist, or podiatrist, or a partner, associate, spouse, or employee of such physician, dentist, or podiatrist is providing medical or health care services at or has an ownership or other financial interest in another hospital, excluding a specialty hospital located in Missouri, or a competing ambulatory surgical center. The proposal defines hospital governing body as well as community.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
