### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator (CTS)** assume the proposed legislation would require that marshals appointed for the appellate courts be compensated in the same amount as the highest salary set for marshals for circuit courts.

Currently, the highest paid marshal (of three) is the 19th circuit marshal, who is paid \$48,831 per year.

The FY 07 budget request indicates the following appellate court salaries for their marshal:

Western District: \$36,444 Eastern District: \$35,076 Southern District (.6 FTE): \$19,548

If all three marshals' salaries were raised to the 19th circuit rate, the total cost would be approximately \$36,093, plus fringe benefits.
