FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would repeal statutes requiring a local circuit court facility at Canton in Lewis County. Since the circuit clerk in Lewis County is paid an additional salary because there are two courthouses in Lewis County (§483.083.2) and court is "held in two cities," the fiscal impact of this legislation would be a savings of \$4,511.00 plus fringe benefits, the pay differential for this position. Since the legislation becomes effective 12/31/06, the savings for FY 07 would be approximately half that amount.

Oversight assumes the City of Canton would experience a savings of any resources appropriated by the city for the circuit court. Oversight assumes the savings to be Unknown.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
