FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of Administration, Division of Facilities Management Design and Construction, the Department of Public Safety, Office of the Director and Missouri Veterans Commission, and the Department of Conservation assume no fiscal impact to their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** assumed that a previous version of this proposal would have no fiscal impact to their organization.

In response to a similar proposal, officials from the **City of Kirksville** assumed their organization would incur additional costs of at least \$123.84 to raise and lower the flags at their various buildings.

Oversight assumes these costs are minimal and could be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** did not respond to our request for information.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would require the Missouri Veterans Commission to notify the Governor after it has received notification from the United States Department of Defense that a member of the United States armed services who was deployed after September 11, 2001, and whose home of record is Missouri has died while on active duty or as a result of injuries suffered while on active duty. The Governor would then be required to issue a proclamation directing all state agencies and political subdivisions of this state to fly the United States flag and the Missouri state flag at half-staff the next day in honor of the service member's service to this country.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
