Officials from the **Missouri Veterans Commission**, the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, the **Coordinating Board of Higher Education**, the **Office of State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Economic Development**, the **Office of Attorney General**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **Missouri State Employees Retirement System**, and the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** assumes this proposal would not fiscally impact their agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** assume this proposal would not fiscally impact the operations of the DOH. DOH states if a fiscal impact were to result, funds to support the program would be sought through the appropriations process.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows a homeless veteran to use the post office box or voice mail address of any charitable or religious organization defined in section 407.453 or any fraternal or veterans' organization, provided that the legitimate purpose of such organization is to provide charitable, religious, fraternal, veterans services and provided that such organization has been providing such legitimate services for a period of at least ten years on applications for federal or state assistance, as long as the organization is willing to provide an address to the homeless veteran for his or her use.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
