FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from **Lincoln University** assume this proposal could have a modest positive fiscal impact on their organization, in the form of tuition revenue.

Officials from Missouri State University, Truman State University, the University of Missouri, Linn State Technical College, Metropolitan Community College, St. Charles Community College, and St. Louis Community College assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** (DHE) assume this proposal would increase the amount of "Bright Flight" awards from \$2,000 to \$4,000 per student. Using the fall 2005 "Bright Flight" recipient total of 8,214 and the increased amount of \$2,000 per recipient, the first year cost would total \$16,428,000. Assuming the number of recipients increases by 1% each year, the total cost would be \$16,592,000 for FY 2008 and \$16,758,000 for FY2009.

ASSUMPTION (continued)

DHE recently implemented a new web-based system for the administration of the state student financial assistance programs. If the award amount were to change after the first scholarship payment was sent out, significant programming changes would need to take place for the system to recognize a different maximum annual award amount. The time required to make adjustments to the system for mid year award changes will not be known until a thorough review has been completed.

Oversight assumes that any changes in maximum award amounts resulting from this proposal would be implemented in advance of processing financial aid for the fall semester, and that DHE could perform any needed system updates with existing resources.
