No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


### DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows insurers to intervene in civil actions where they may be obligated to provide a defense or indemnity for any judgment rendered in the action. The court will determine the extent of the insurer's coverage obligations, but its decision may be appealed. Any action by the insurer will not constitute a breach of contract.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
