FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Currently, a tenant-defendant, in an action by the landlord for payment of overdue rent, must pay any money judgment and court costs after the date of the original trial, but before any trial de novo to avoid any taking of possession of the rental premises by the landlord. The proposed legislation requires a defendant to pay a money judgment after the original trial and before any application for or actual trial de novo.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
