No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

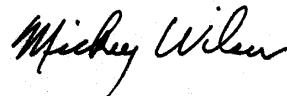
DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows drugs donated to the Prescription Drug Repository Program that are not used or accepted by any pharmacy, hospital, or non-profit clinic in this state to be distributed to out-of-state charitable repositories for use outside of the state.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
