DESCRIPTION

This proposal specifies that informed consent is not required for research programs or experimental medical procedures for patients subject to a life-threatening emergency when the institutional review board responsible for the review, approval and continuing review of the research activity has approved both the research activity and a waiver of informed consent and has found and documented that the requirements for an exception from informed consent requirements for emergency research as required by Federal regulation have been satisfied.

The bill contains an emergency clause.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
