### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development - Division of Professional Registration (DED-PR)** estimate that the board would meet six (6) times per year for two (2) days and the cost per board member would be \$395. Four (4) fewer board members would result in lowering the cost of each meeting by \$1,581 or \$9,486 annually beginning in FY 08.

**Oversight** notes the number of board members in Section 329.190 is seven. The proposal as written does not change the number of board members. Therefore, **Oversight** assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact on the DED-PR.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION
